


AN AFTERNOON IN TULSA

NDUSTRY REPORT

The beauty industry is constantly evolving, with innovative and creative opportunities around every corner. That's why we track trends in each of our specialized fields and give you the latest scoop on what's trending.

IT'S A GOOD TIME TO CARE ABOUT SKINCARE.

The job outlook for estheticians, as reported by The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), is on a significant upswing, with opportunities in the field expected to grow 40% between 2012 and 2022 (*www.bls.gov*), far surpassing the national average growth rate of 11% for all occupations.

The influx is largely attributed the rising demand for both medical and cosmetic skin care treatments, with the industry employing the most estheticians being personal care services and the highest paying opportunities coming from medical and surgical hospitals, which paid estheticians an annual average salary of \$47,430.


